

Overview

Radiologists are eligible to claim Continuing Professional Development (CPD) credits for peer learning rounds. *Participants* may be eligible for up to 4.5 credits, and *convenors* up to 6.5 credits. The tables below summarize eligible credits for each role.

CPD credit eligibility for radiology peer learning rounds

PARTICIPANTS	
Credit type	Credit eligibility
Section 1 <i>Group learning (rounds)</i>	- Accredited - 1 credit per hour - Unaccredited - 0.5 credits per hour
Section 3 <i>Feedback and Improvement: Feedback delivered</i>	These credits are for the learning that occurs for Dr. X during delivery process i.e. putting feedback together, providing feedback, or learning about how the feedback was received. 3 credits per hour (max. 15 credits per year). Round up to the closest quarter hour (i.e. 15, 30, 45 mins.)
Section 3 <i>Feedback and Improvement: Feedback received</i>	These credits are for the learning that occurs for Dr. X when submitting and presenting a case and reflecting on the feedback, with the purpose of setting next steps for improvement. 3 credits per hour. Learning in 30 minutes = 1.5 credits. Rounded up to the closest quarter (i.e. 15, 30, 45 min. etc.).

Participant example:

Radiologist X participates 1-hour of peer learning rounds. In the session, 3 cases are discussed; one of which was submitted by Radiologist X, who receives feedback from the group.

Radiologist X is then eligible for:



- 0.5 Section 1 credits for 1-hour attendance (*Unaccredited .5 credits per hour*)
- 3.0 Section 3 credits for participating in all 3 case discussions and providing feedback. (*3 credits / hour*)
- 1.0 Section 3 credits for submitting one's own case to receive feedback (*20 mins. discussion + feedback*)
- 4.5 Total (0.5 Section 1 credits and 4.0 Section 3 credits)

CONVENORS	
Credit type	Credit eligibility
Section 1 <i>Group Learning (rounds)</i>	- Accredited - 1 credit per hour - Unaccredited - 0.5 credits per hour
Section 2 <i>Individual Learning: Activity preparation</i>	These credits are for the time spent preparing for and coordinating the rounds. 2 credits per hour (max 15 credits per year)
Section 3 <i>Feedback and Improvement: Feedback delivered</i>	These credits are for the learning that occurs for Dr. X during delivery process i.e. putting feedback together, providing feedback, or learning about how the feedback was received. 3 credits per hour - As the convenor you will participate in all conversations in the rounds, and are eligible to claim the full time of the rounds.
Section 3 <i>Feedback and Improvement: Feedback received</i>	These credits are for the learning that occurs for Dr. X when submitting and presenting a case and reflecting on the feedback, with the purpose of setting next steps for improvement. 3 credits per hour - If as a convenor you have submitted and presented your own case, you are eligible to claim the full time of the rounds.

Convenor example:

Radiologist X convenes 1-hour of peer learning rounds. In the session, 3 cases are discussed; one of which was submitted by the convenor themselves, who receives feedback from the group.

Radiologist X is then eligible for:



- 0.5 Section 1 credits for 1-hour attendance (*Unaccredited .5 credits per hour*)
- 2.0 Section 2 credits for preparing a one hour peer learning rounds session (*2 credits/hour.*)
- 3.0 Section 3 credits for participating in all 3 case discussions and providing feedback. (*3 credits / hour*)
- 1.0 Section 3 credits for submitting one's own case to receive feedback (*20 mins. discussion + feedback*)
- 6.5 Total (0.5 Section 1 credits, 2.0 Section 2 credits, and 4.0 Section 3 credits)
